BE IT RESOLVED, the Rowan County Board of Elections, pursuant to the authority granted under North Carolina G.S. 163-128, has combined North China Grove Precinct and South China Grove Precinct.

The new description, name and number of new precinct is as follows:

CHINA GROVE 05A

Beginning at Hwy 152 and Patterson Street, follow Patterson Street to Kimball Road. Follow the Landis City Limit Line (North Side of Kimball Road) till you get to the China Grove City Limit Line. Follow the China Grove City Limit Lines to Main Street. Follow Main Street north to Eudy Road; follow Eudy Road southeast to Chapel Street. Follow Chapel Street east to Bostian Road; follow Bostian Road southeast to Hwy 29. Follow Hwy 29 north to the creek; follow the creek southeast to another creek that runs beside Interstate 85. Follow that creek north to Hwy 152; follow Hwy 152 east to the Litaker and China Grove Township lines. Follow the township lines northwest till you meet the Locke and China Grove Township lines. Follow those township lines west till you meet the Atwell and China Grove Township lines. Follow those township lines southwest till you come to Brown Road. Follow Brown Road southeast till you get to Hwy 152 and Patterson Street, the beginning point.

All voters living within the above area are in China Grove Precinct.

Voter Tabulation District number would stay 05 for North China Grove and 06 for South China Grove. Therefore, China Grove will consist of VTD's 05 & 06.

Polling Place for China Grove Precinct 05A will be China Grove Community Building.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Rowan County Board of Elections, pursuant to the authority granted under North Carolina G.S. 163-128, has combined East Landis Precinct and West Landis Precinct.

The new description, name and number of new precinct is as follows:

LANDIS 19A

Beginning at the Railroad tracks and Eudy Road, follow Eudy Road east to Chapel Street then follow Chapel Street east to Bostian Road follow Bostian Road south to Hwy 29. Follow Hwy 29 north to a creek. Follow the creek southeast to another creek running along Interstate 85 near Daugherty Road. Follow that creek south till it meets to another creek near China Grove Road. Follow that creek west and northwest till you reach Hwy 29. Follow Hwy 29 west then south around the Kannapolis City Limit Lines. Follow the Kannapolis City limit line north and around till it meets Landis City limit line at Airport Road. Follow the Landis City limit line around till it meets back with the Kannapolis City limit line near West A Street, then follow the Kannapolis – Landis City limit line west till the Kannapolis City limit continues. Follow the Kannapolis City limits west and north around till you reach Cannon Farm Road, and then follow Cannon Farm Road till you reach Atwell Township line. Follow the Atwell Township line north to Brown Road, follow Brown Road south to Hwy 152. Cross Hwy 152 and continue on Patterson Street to Kimball Road. Follow the Landis City Limit Line (north side of Kimball Road) till you get to the China Grove City Limit Line. Follow the China Grove City Limit line to Main Street. Follow Main Street north to Eudy Road. Follow Eudy Road to the Railroad Tracks, the beginning point.

All voters living within the above area are in Landis Precinct.

Voter Tabulation District number would stay 19 for West Landis and 20 for East Landis. Therefore, Landis will consist of VTD's 19 & 20.

Polling Place for Landis Precinct #19A will be Rowan Public Library (South Branch)

BE IT RESOLVED, the Rowan County Board of Elections, pursuant to the authority granted under North Carolina G.S. 163-128, has combined North Granite Quarry Precinct and South Granite Quarry Precinct.

The new description, name and number of new precinct is as follows:

GRANITE QUARRY #14A

Beginning at the Salisbury City Limit Line on Stokes Ferry Road, follow Stokes Ferry Road south to Oddie Road. Follow Oddie Road south to St. Lukes Church Road, and then follow St. Lukes Church Road west to Hwy 52. Follow Hwy 52 south to Crescent Road. Follow Crescent Road west to the Gold Hill Litaker Township Line. Follow the township line till you get to Faith Town Limits. Follow the town limits around and back to the Township Line. Follow the Granite Quarry Town Limits as to encompass the town limits till you get back to the township line at Faith Road. Follow the township line north till you meet the Salisbury City Limit Line. Follow the Salisbury City Limit Line north then northeast till you get to Stokes Ferry Road, the beginning point.

Voter Tabulation District number would stay #14 for North Granite Quarry and #46 for South Granite Quarry. Therefore, Granite Quarry will consist of VTD's 14 & 46.

All voters living within the above area are in Granite Quarry Precinct.


Polling Place for Granite Quarry Precinct #14A will be Granite Quarry Municipal Building
