

## 2010 Landis Pool Rules and Regulations

THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE FOR THE PROTECTION AND BENEFIT OF ALL USERS OF THE POOL FACILITIES AND ARE DESIGNED TO ASSURE SAFE AND SANITARY OPERATION OF THE POOL. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF ALL PARENTS TO INSTRUCT THEIR CHILDREN TO OBSERVE AND OBEY ALL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS OF THE LIFEGUARDS AND POOL MANAGER.

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF POOL PRIVILEGES!**

1. Children 12 years of age and under must be accompanied by a responsible person, 16 years of age or older.
2. Each member and visitor is required to log in at the desk before entering the pool area.
3. Abusive or objectionable language (profanity), will not be permitted or tolerated.
4. No running, pushing, or horse-play.
5. No playing on ladders, guard towers, or ropes.
6. No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia.
7. No gum, food, or drinks allowed in front of the yellow line.
8. No smoking allowed in the pool or inside the fenced area.
9. Glass or other breakable objects are not permitted inside the fence area.
10. All trash must be placed in proper receptacles.
11. Diving Board Rules:
  - a) Mount to diving board from end of board
  - b) Only one diver on board at a time.
  - c) Diving from end of board only-dive straight out.
  - d) Wait until preceding diver swims clear of board.
  - e) No double bouncing.
  - f) No hanging from the diving board.
12. The First aid kit is under supervision of the pool staff. All injuries should be reported to the pools staff.
13. Emergency equipment for lifeguard use only.
14. No refunds due to weather.
15. Wading Pool Rules:
  - a) The wading pool is for children 6 years of age and under.
  - b) Children must be supervised by a parent or other responsible person.
  - c) Lifeguards will not be stationed at the wading pool.
  - d) Applicable pool rules and regulations must be observed in the wading pool.
16. No diapers allowed in the pool; only proper "swim diapers" allowed.
17. Only proper swim wear allowed in the pool (no sports bras, or cut-offs allowed).
18. ONLY THE NAMES OF THE PEOPLE ON THE MEMBERSHIP WILL BE ALLOWED IN ON THAT MEMBERSHIP.
19. Memberships are valid only for families which reside in a single household together. The maximum number of people on a membership is 6; each additional family member is \$15.00.

**Private Parties (by reservation only):** Saturday & Sunday: 6pm-9pm (\$225.00 - Inside and Outside City limits).
