History

DC and Frances Linn donated the real estate located behind the Police and Sheriff's departments on Ryder and with the intent of the Town using the property for a passive park.



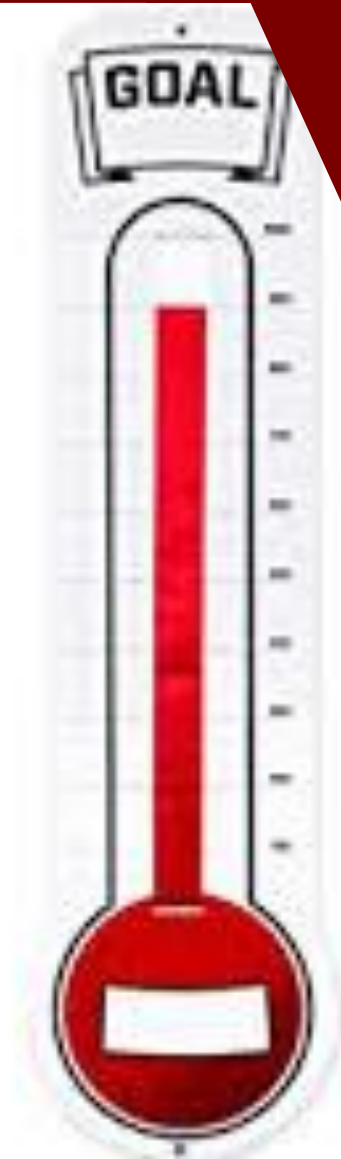
What is a Passive Park?

A park that is designed for use in an unstructured or informal way. Typically less developed than an active park; but may contain gardens, seating, fountains, and a stage.



Why a Passive Park?

The Linns traveled extensively in South America and Europe where towns were developed around a park or town square. Passive Parks are often central not only in geography but also to the lives of the citizens. They wanted the Park to be like the Town's living room.



Funding

The Linns were generous in their planning to support the Park. Multiple parcels of land throughout Town were donated with the intent of their sale to help fund development and maintenance of the Park. Current balance in the fund is \$264,591.01.
