### Announcement Regarding the Landis Board of Aldermen Meeting Scheduled for March 8, 2021

With the easing of Covid-19 restrictions from the governor's office and some positive news regarding vaccination and infection rates, I believe we can safely begin to consider easing restrictions regarding attendance to board meetings and access to town hall; but we need to proceed with caution. Access to town hall will continue to be limited to walk-up traffic or by appointment. Masks will continue to be required. This policy will be reviewed in time for a possible April reopening.

As we have a number of outside speakers on the upcoming agenda, the March 8<sup>th</sup> Town of Landis Board of Aldermen meeting will again be limited to members of the board, staff and those invited to speak. Social distancing and masks will continue to be observed to the extent possible. The meeting, which begins at 6:00 PM, will be available for live or recorded viewing by citizens and interested parties on our YouTube channel. With a full month of additional vaccinations expected to occur within Rowan County, I expect the April meeting to be open to the public.
