Removal and Repair of the Town of Landis' Drop Box

Most citizens who have used the Town of Landis' drop box, located at the back corner of Town Hall, are likely aware that the unit is in dire need of modernization. In addition to the drop box being positioned too far away from the curb to be easily reached for many, it is also positioned too low for proper use. Other concerns are that envelopes in the storage box often get wet during major rains and water actually seeps into the box itself. Help is on the way.

This Thursday, December 17th, the unit will be removed in order to be refabricated for placement at the proper height and distance from the curb. It will also be made waterproof to protect documents inside the drop box as well as the envelope storage box. The plan is for the drop box to be returned no later than noon the following day, Friday, December 18th.

We ask for your patience and cooperation during this transition. During regular office hours, payment can be made at the new walk-up payment window located at the front of Town Hall. Customers who are immobile or need assistance in any manner may call us at (704)857-2411 and we will come outside to take your payment during this short period of reconstruction. Since the drop box will be unavailable from December 17th through December 18th, after hour payments may be made online only.
